HELPFUL HINTS

When planning a project whereby you will be expecting materials to be delivered by a heavy goods vehicle it would be helpful to bear in mind the following:

- 1.** If the driver is asked to leave the public highway, any resulting damage to the vehicle or property is the customer's responsibility.
- 2.** Be aware of overhead cables, most HGV's require a minimum of 11ft headroom extending to 30ft if it's a tipper
- 3.** If the required delivery is into a driveway, there must be a minimum gap of 9ft 6ins between gateposts. Also you should be aware of any shallow drains under the driveway. They may crack under the weight of the vehicle, as will manhole covers that are not heavy duty.
